Mr. Herb K. Schultz serves as senior advisor to Governor Schwarzenegger. Most recently, he has served as Vice President of Government Programs for McKesson Health Solutions, where he oversaw the company's disease management and nurse advice programs for Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries. Schultz previously was Acting Director of the California Employment Development Department in the first year of Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger's Administration. He served as a member of then-Governor Gray Davis' Cabinet as Acting Secretary for the Labor and Workforce Development Agency. Mr. Schultz was appointed Undersecretary before his Cabinet-level appointment, and remained in both roles until the end of the Davis Administration.
